- Use of Imaging Studies for Low Back Pain
- Cervical Cancer Screening
- Weight Assessment & Counseling for Nutrition & Physical Activity for Children & Adolescents
- Comprehensive Diabetes Care (e.g. Eye exam, LDL-C screening & control, HbA1c testing & control, medical attention for Nephropathy, blood pressure)
- Avoidance of Antibiotic Treatment in Adults with Acute Bronchitis
- HbA1c Testing indicator used for Auto Assignment (Diabetes)
- Children & Adolescents' Access to Primary Care Practitioners*
