Outreach to the Homeless in Los Angeles County



9/4 - At the **Midnight Mission** in downtown LA, the weekly men's health group received a presentation on

Medi-Cal changes and the benefits of Cal MediConnect. The nonprofit agency offers a path to self-sufficiency to men, women and children who have lost everything, and has advocated for homeless people's self-sufficiency for 100 years.



Riverside County

- **9/3 - Attendees of the Senior Services Fair in Hemet** participated in a presentation and received informational material about Cal MediConnect. They had the opportunity to have their questions answered, and were given important information about HCO, HICAP, and the health plans in order to make decisions once they receive their blue envelopes.



Santa Clara County

- **9/3 - In the first of a two-part series, Spanish- and Mandarin-speaking residents of Plaza de las Flores** attended CCI overview presentations with language translation. About 40 Mandarin-speaking residents engaged in a lively discussion about what resources are available to help seniors make a choice about selecting a health plan.

Presentation at a Care1st Center in Los Angeles County

8/28 - People eligible for Cal MediConnect at **Care1st's Resource Center** learned about enrollment into Cal MediConnect during presentations in both English and Spanish. They learned about how to use the Choice Form, enrollment choices, the notice process, and additional resources like HICAP and HCO.



Los Angeles County

- **9/6** - CCI coordinators staffed a table with information in English and Spanish at **Community Coalition's 3rd Annual Power Fest** at Martin Luther King Park in southern Los Angeles. Power Fest is a free festival that attracts thousands of families from South Los Angeles in a day of celebration, empowerment, and education.

San Diego County

- **9/3** - IHSS providers learned more about Cal MediConnect at the **UDW monthly presentation**. Participants were able to ask questions about the CCI's benefits, care coordination, MLTSS, and the enrollment process. Fact sheets with contact numbers for HICAP and Health Care Options were also made available.
- **9/5** - The **San Diego County Council on Aging** hosted the **Living Lively Expo**, a conference for seniors, caregivers and industry professionals. Participants learned about the improved coordination of services between Medicare and Medi-Cal under the program, and how continuity of care enables CCI participants to keep seeing out-of-network providers even after joining Cal MediConnect.
