Note: LIS reassigees will be assessed every year and if the number is sufficient, they will be passively enrolled into Cal MediConnect in January.

<sup>1</sup> COHS counties (Orange and San Mateo counties) are already mandatorily enrolling new duals into MLTSS plans. Partial duals will also be mandatorily enrolled into MLTSS plans, per existing CCI enrollment policies.

<sup>2</sup> This includes San Mateo, which will conduct passive enrollment in one month (no sooner than September 2016). The initial passive enrollment phase is already underway in Orange County and will run through July 2016. No additional passive enrollment in Orange County in 2016 is planned.
