Managed Medi-Cal Long-Term Services and Supports (MLTSS) Mailings to Begin

DHCS will begin mailing the new Medi-Cal Managed Care Plan Resource Guide and Choice Book in early November. These materials will be mailed to two groups of dual eligible beneficiaries as a part of their regular enrollment process: (1) new dual eligible beneficiaries who have Medicare first and later gain Medi-Cal eligibility in CCI counties; and (2) existing dual eligible

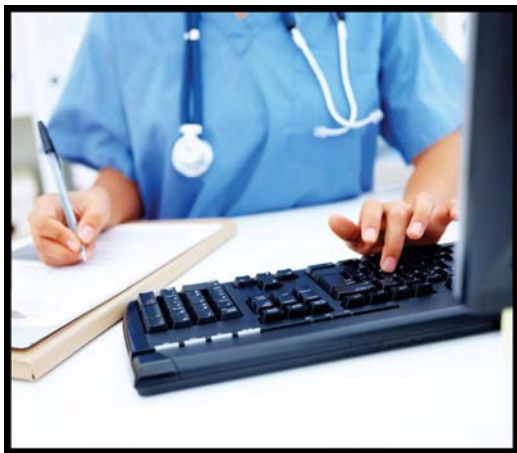
